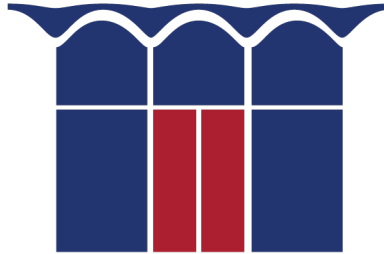


# Gardella Honors House Code of Conduct

Use of Gardella Honors House is a privilege offered to University Honors Program students and is governed by a strictly enforced Code of Conduct. Students are issued a key granting access to Gardella at the beginning of their college career and are required to return the key upon graduation or upon leaving the program. Students must sign the Gardella House Code of Conduct form prior to receiving their key. Students who lose or do not return their key will be charged \$25 for its replacement. Any violation of the Gardella Honors House Code of Conduct and/or the University Honors Program Code of Conduct will result in the forfeiture of Gardella House privileges and possible expulsion from the Honors program.

Signing the Gardella House Code of Conduct is a pledge to preserve the safety, security, and cleanliness of the Gardella Honors House; to use Gardella for its intended purpose of studying and socializing; and to respect other members of the University Honors Program and their guests when using the space.
