ISO will be open normal business hours during the break

Are you traveling **within** the United States during the break? If so, please keep the following documents with you:

- Copy of your I-94
- Copy of your health insurance card
- Copy of your passport

Are you traveling **outside** the United States during the break? If so, confirm the following before departing:

- **REQUIRED:** You have your I-20 and it has a signature on the 2nd page for travel. EACH SIGNATURE IS VALID FOR ONE YEAR. If your travel signature will be older than one year when you return (ie, a March 1, 2017 signature) please come to ISO for a new signature before you depart
- **REQUIRED:** You have an entry visa valid on the day you plan to re-enter the US
- A copy of your Winter 2018 class schedule (this is not required to re-enter the US, but is advised)
